Committee Description

The purpose of this committee is to:

1. Establish financial fundraising goals for each year.
2. Determine the major fundraising events and efforts for the year (e.g, named bricks in the backyard, dinner clubs, ads in the directory, dinner to honor the Rabbi, Ravinia Night, Art in the Park, etc.)
3. Appoint people to coordinate and work on each project.
4. Monitor progress of each project planning group.
5. Report progress to the FMC and LC.

Role of Committee Members

1. Attend periodic meetings.
2. Accept coordinating responsibility for at least one project.
3. Make phone calls to make sure projects are on track.
4. Work with the Office Administrator on promotion of projects and other administrative tasks.
