

Mensch Committee:

Goal: The **Mensch Committee's** goal is to manage the dues collection process for Beth Hillel Temple in such a way that all feel welcome regardless of financial status while facilitating the collection of dues in an equitable manner which sustains the Temple.

Tasks:

1. Is responsible for monitoring and analysis of dues collection.
2. Provides information on expected income from dues during the budgeting process.
3. Is aware of all dues collected and provides information to the FMT about dues management on a regular basis.
4. Makes recommendations to the Leadership Council and to the Temple Administrator to streamline the dues collection and membership management processes.

Roles of Committee Members:

- Meet periodically with committee (approximately once every 2 to 3 months).
- Contact members who need a Mensch Committee contact (each committee member will be assigned specific members with whom they will be the liaison over time).
- Report back to the committee on the outcome of the contact.
- Committee members must be willing and able to keep the content of the committee work strictly confidential.

Why be a part of the Mensch Committee?

Beth Hillel Temple is a small, inclusive, welcoming Jewish community. We depend on dues to provide the majority of the Temple budget yet we are committed to never turning away any potential member for financial reasons. The Mensch Committee manages the dues collection process in a way to facilitate the sustenance of the Temple while making all welcome. Committee members play an important role for the on-going welfare of our congregation.
