

Volunteer Team:

Goal: The volunteer team's goal is to effectively recruit, retain, and appreciate volunteers at Beth Hillel Temple.

Tasks:

- 1) Gather information about volunteer roles at the temple – including committee, school, and event work.
- 2) Assess volunteer needs and determine ways to recruit members to fill those needs.
- 3) Provide periodic orientations about volunteer opportunities for new members and others looking to get involved
- 4) Coordinate volunteer appreciation/recognition efforts at events, annual meeting, through newsletter, with rabbi, etc.
- 5) Report on volunteer efforts and needs in newsletter
- 6) Provide ongoing support and mentoring for volunteer efforts

Roles of Committee Members:

- Meet periodically with team (approx once every 6 weeks)
- Write articles for newsletter
- Gather information on volunteer roles
- Recruit volunteers for events, committees and other needs
- Work with rabbi to offer appreciation opportunities
- Support/mentor volunteers
- Lead volunteer appreciation efforts
